Missouri

St. Charles, St. Louis, or St. Louis City.

Teachers will receive:

- A free educator tool-kit.
- Learning materials aligned to Common Core and Next-Generation Science Standards.
- Access to funding for stewardship projects.
- Bus transportation and substitute teacher funding for Swarovski Watershool related field trips (e.g. tour of a water treatment facility, lessons at NGRREC, etc.)
- Professional development hours (up to 12 hours).
- An opportunity to connect their class with students from another global Swarovski Waterschool program in Austria, Brazil, China, India, Thailand, or Uganda.
